





The ABCs of Securing a Home Field

- 1. Contact the field's owners city, school district, or private club
- 2. Get EXACT address of field.
- 3. Confirm the field is in good condition no pot holes, no sprinkler heads sticking out.
- **4.** Find out the schedule for watering, grass cutting, and lining of fields for the summer months. Remember, if the field is NOT watered, the fields will get very hard.
- **5.** Get contact information (email, cell #) for the person who is in charge of field maintenance. Some you can contact the day of the game if there is an issue.
- **6.** If your home field is **new**, complete the Field Insurance request form. The form can be found on the 'documents' page of the league website, www.GLWSL.org
- 7. If your home field is the **same** as last year, you still must do all of the above.
- **8.** When the preliminary schedule comes out, check with the field owners to make sure the dates/times are ok. Notify the league for any conflicts.
- 9. Once the final summer schedule is out, again confirm the dates with the field owners.
- **10.** You will receive a certificate of insurance before your first game. You MUST have at all games. Put in you in "Team Manager Manual".

<u>NOTE: Obtaining field insurance</u> - Field insurance contract must be obtained by MSA 48 hours prior to scheduled match or it will be canceled. In order to have your insurance contract in at a timely manner, GLWSL requires you submit your paper work to the league 10 working days prior to the scheduled match to avoid complications.
